Friday, December 13:

The following penalties were assessed:

Collegiate Team Relay:

For failing to draw even before starting the relay: 10” penalty

- Brevard College
- Fort Lewis College
- Lees-McRae College

For a rider finishing a lap failing to cross the Finish Line before the rider entering the race: 30” penalty

- University of Arizona

Non-Championship Mixed Team Relay:

For failing to draw even before starting the relay: 10” penalty
Team numbers 04, 13, 14, 25, 28, 33

For Saturday, December 14:

Staging and Starts:

UCI Categories on Saturday: The top 8 riders will stage on the outside of turn 1 on the pavement. Tires and bikes will be checked for these riders as soon as they are in the grid. They will be called to the grid at about 4:30 before the start.

Pit Entry & Compartment: For UCI events, lanyard credentials **must be presented** when entering the pit. Have your lanyard pit pass ready to show before entering. Know the box number to which your rider(s) are assigned. Pit box assignments are posted on the call ups for each race on the official event website.

Please respect the pit lane. Only mechanics with an off-handed rider are permitted on the fence line, and only while preparing for possible service of their rider(s). Do not encroach on the pit lane or cross the pit lane to encourage riders from the fence. Bikes are not to be held in the middle of the pit lane. Please keep them close to the pit box.



Rider Numbers: Two Shoulder numbers and two bib numbers are issued to every rider. It is *essential* that *all four numbers* are properly worn during the event.

- Forearm numbers should be visible from the front. Avoid placing them on the sides, back, or under the armpit.
- Bib numbers are to be placed “USA Criterium Style” – one on each side with a gap between (when possible) on the back, with the bottom of the number aligned with and slightly above the side seam of the jersey.
- Bib numbers replace the chip timing system.
- Failure to properly display bib numbers will result in a \$20 fine and possible relegation. Help us help you be identified in the race and on TV.
