

JUNIOR GRAVEL SERIES 2026: ELEVATE YOUR GAME

The path to the National Team starts on the gravel.

The Junior Gravel Series returns for an exciting 2026 season, providing the nation's top junior riders (ages 15–18) with a premier platform to compete, earn points, and gain exposure to national-level development opportunities. This series is designed to reward performance, consistency, and competitive depth across a diverse and challenging national calendar.

2026 Series Structure & Calendar

The 2026 Junior Gravel Series will consist of 10 events, combining established cornerstone races with new additions that expand geographic reach and competitive opportunity.

Eligibility & Licensing Requirements

To be eligible for inclusion in the Overall Junior Gravel Series Standings, riders must hold a valid annual USA Cycling license for the 2026 season.

- Individual Events: A USA Cycling license is not required to compete in individual Junior Gravel Series events (excluding the USA Cycling Gravel National Championship, which follows standard USA Cycling licensing requirements).
- Overall Series Eligibility: Only riders holding an active annual USA Cycling license will be eligible to earn points toward, and be ranked in, the Overall Series Standings.

Riders without an annual license may compete in eligible events and earn event results, but will not be included in the overall series rankings.

Incentives & Rewards

- National Championship Entry: Any junior rider (15–16 or 17–18 categories) who wins an individual series race will receive free entry into the 2026 USA Cycling Gravel National Championship.
- Talent ID Camp Consideration (October 2026):
 - The 17–18 Overall Series Champion will receive an automatic invite to the Talent ID Camp, pending continued program offering.
 - Riders in the 15–16 category will not receive an automatic invite, but will be evaluated for selection based on performance throughout the season.

How to Qualify for Overall Standings

The series utilizes a cumulative points system across all sanctioned events, with only a rider's three highest-scoring results counting toward the Overall Series Standings.

- Minimum Starts: Riders must compete in a minimum of 3 series races to be included in the official Overall Series Standings.
- Standings Calculation: Once the 3-race minimum is met, Overall Series rankings are determined by the total points from each rider's three highest-scoring races. Additional

starts beyond three may improve a rider's standing by replacing lower scores, but do not increase the number of results counted.

Revised 2026 Point Scoring System

All series events will utilize a scoring system that rewards both finishing position and field size.

Standard Placement Points (P)

1st: 50 | 2nd: 45 | 3rd: 41 | 4th: 37 | 5th: 34 | 6th: 31 | 7th: 28 | 8th: 26
9th: 24 | 10th: 22 | 11th: 20 | 12th: 18 | 13th: 17 | 14th: 16 | 15th: 15 | 16th: 14
17th: 13 | 18th: 12 | 19th: 11 | 20th: 10 | 21st: 9 | 22nd: 8 | 23rd: 7 | 24th: 6
25th: 5 | 26th: 4 | 27th: 3 | 28th: 2 | 29th–30th: 1

All other starters not disqualified will receive 1 point.

Starter Bonus Points (B)

Riders receive a Starter Bonus equal to the total number of starters in their field.

Total Points = Placement Points (P) + Starter Bonus (B)

Example:

- Winner in a 50-rider field: $50 + 50 = 100$ points
- Winner in a 10-rider field: $50 + 10 = 60$ points
