



USA Cycling Foundation Trip Payment & Cancellation Terms

Payment

A nonrefundable deposit of 10% of the total trip cost is due at the time of booking to secure your spot. A secure credit card payment link will be provided (subject to standard credit card processing fees) during registration.

Final payment invoices will be sent via email 60 days prior to the trip start date and will include a secure credit card payment link. The remaining balance is due 30 days prior to departure.

Upon request, we are also happy to issue an invoice for payment by check, wire, or ACH.

Cancellation

Cancellations made 30 days or more prior to the trip start date will receive a refund, excluding the non-refundable 10% deposit. **Cancellations within 30 days of the trip start date, or after trip start, are non-refundable and guests are responsible for the full trip cost.**

Incidentals

Any incidental expenses incurred during the trip will be charged individually following the conclusion of the program.

Incidentals invoices will be sent approximately two weeks after the trip ends and are due within 30 days of the invoice date.

Final incidental charges may vary by guest and reflect actual costs incurred. Supporting documentation can be provided upon request.

Transferability

If you are unable to attend, your spot and trip costs (minus the 10% nonrefundable deposit) may be transferred to another participant with prior approval from the USA Cycling Foundation, is subject to equipment availability, and provided the request is made at least 30 days prior to the trip start date.

Within 30 days of departure, transfer requests may be considered on a case-by-case basis and are subject to equipment, inventory, and logistical availability.

Trip Cancellation by Organizer

In the rare event that a trip must be canceled or materially altered due to circumstances beyond our control, such as weather, government restrictions, safety concerns, or event changes, refunds will be issued based on costs recoverable from vendors and suppliers and minus the 10% nonrefundable deposit.

Late or Missed Payments

If final payment is not received by the stated due date, we reserve the right to release the reservation and apply the applicable cancellation terms.

Travel Insurance

We strongly recommend purchasing comprehensive travel insurance that includes coverage for trip cancellation, medical expenses, and emergency evacuation.

Currency and Fees

All trip payments are invoiced in U.S. dollars. Guests are responsible for any bank, wire, or processing fees associated with credit card, ACH, or check payments.
