



SAFE SPORT EVENT CHECKLIST

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These checklist items are contained in the electronic Post-Event form in the USA Cycling Permitting System. When filling in the Post-Event Information, you (the Event Organizer), or your Chief Referee, will be asked to complete these checklist items. This stand-alone version is meant to be a resource for the person completing the electronic Post-Event submission.
