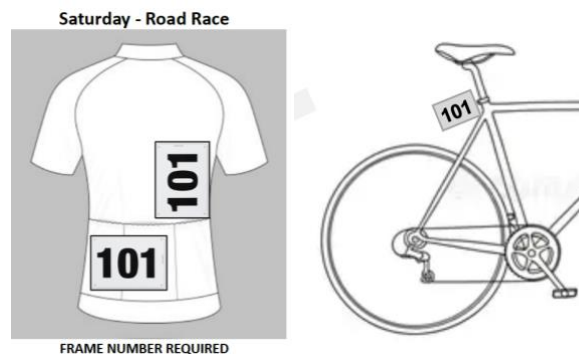

Road Race Notes

Registration: Registration will be located in team parking for the road race, changed from inside Trek Headquarters.

Rider Identification: Riders are reminded to wear two bib numbers and one frame number for the road race. Frame numbers and bib numbers should be worn in the pictured configuration:

Rider Clothing: As a reminder, per USAC regulation 6E2, all riders on a given team must wear identifiably similar jerseys.

Call-Ups: During call-ups, only one team member should advance to the line when their team name is called.

Feeding: Team and neutral feeding is only permitted in the feed zone from the right side of the road. No hand-ups are permitted outside of the feed zone or from vehicles. Litter may only be discarded in the green zone, indicated by A-frame signs. Any littering outside of this area is subject to penalties. Feeding will open the second passage through the feed zone and remain open through the last passage of the feed zone for all categories.

Riders Out of Contention: Riders who are more than 8% behind the field of their respective races will be directed left at the lap cards to turn onto McKay Way for the finishing stretch. Riders will be awarded places based on their order across the finish line and must cross the finish line to receive a placing. All riders outside of the caravan are subject to rules of the road prior to their turn onto McKay Way and should exercise caution. Riders out of contention will be penalized for obstructing race vehicles or other traffic.
