



Communique 6 USA Cycling Pro Road National Championships

General:

Sign on will be open 1h10 before the start and closes at (8:50 W / 12:50 M), on Laidley, just behind the finish line. Random equipment checks will be conducted before the start. Neutral Service will be available near this location.

Radios are allowed for both Women and Men.

If you require service, please signal your request at the back of the field so we can call teams or neutral service for you as quickly as possible.

Feeding:

This year a new regulation is in effect. Article 2.3.025. Feeding must be done either from the car or in authorized feed zones. These zones are listed in the technical guide. Additionally, feeding in the feed zones must be no more than 1 meter from the edge of the road. Please return bottles to the cars (including comm cars) and utilize the signed litter zones to dispose of waste. Careful disposal of bottles where fans are present is allowed. Disposing of waste outside of these conditions is subject to fines.

Feeding from the ground outside of these zones is prohibited and subject to fines.

Opening/Closing

Feeding at feed zones will start from the feed zone, westbound on Kanawha, on the second opening lap.

The last feeding will be from the feed zone, eastbound on Kanawha, on the final lap. Feeding will be open from the cars per the regulations at 30 km into the race and will close at 20 km to go. Remember that there are significant portions of the course that are on significant uphills and descents where feeding will not be possible. We will work to allow feeding wherever possible within the information given above.

Reminders:

Number placement is road style (both vertical with separation), or right number vertical and left number horizontal (crit style).

In groups of 15 or less, feeding from the back of that bunch is allowed after asking permission from the commissaire with that group.

Riders out of contention or significantly behind and safety resources cannot be deployed for their protection, will be withdrawn from the race. A broom wagon will be in place throughout the race for riders who abandon. Every attempt will be made to notify and pull riders at the finish line. Please listen for those announcements on the road. If you abandon in the feed zone or into a team car, please let the commissaires know.

Penalties are UCI scale, (Article 2, section 12.007, third column.)
